COSTUME PICK-UP

Costume Pickup will be held on Saturday, May 4th, 10:00-2:00 & Sunday, May 5th, 1:00-4:00 in Studio A.

If you are unable to pick-up costumes during these times, please contact Janna to schedule an alternate appointment. Your family account must be in good standing with no repeated late payments in order to pick up costumes. If your account has multiple late payments, you will need to be at a zero balance in order to pick up. If your account is not in good standing by Wednesday, May 8th, your dancer will not be able to participate in the rehearsals or recital.

Costumes will only be given out to parents or dancers who are age 16 or older. (No exceptions)

Any costumes that are not picked up by May 8th will be taken to Lane Community College for final pick up. Any costumes not picked up by June 1st will be donated to a charitable organization.

Alterations: It is inevitable that not every costume will fit every child perfectly. Hosanna Dance does not have the resources to provide alterations for your student(s). It is the family's responsibility to arrange for any necessary alterations. If you do need assistance making alterations, we can recommend several families that may be able to help you for a small fee.

Please note your dancer's arrival time(s) and plan to be in the auditorium seats by that time. Dancers will need to stay until they are dismissed. On Wednesday, the 4:15 arrival group will be dismissed before the 5:30 group begins. On Friday, the Buddy & Me dancers will be dismissed before the next group begins.

*Kinder Ballet and Ballet 6-8 Beginning/Intermediate will have extra time to practice before the full show run through. Please plan to stay until they are dismissed.



REHEARSAL - CREATIVE & 6-8 CLASSES

- Arrive ready to dance
 - Dancers must enter the auditorium in full costume with hair and make-up ready for rehearsal. Please plan ahead and give yourself plenty of time.
 - Some costumes (tutus for example) are hard to seatbelt in, so you may want to wait and put your child's costume on in the car after you arrive.
 - We recommend wearing leggings over tights to protect those new tights! Dancers in multiple classes can give their extra costume(s) to their class helper when they check in.
- Backstage access & tour
 - After announcements, you will be directed to drop off your child with his/her assigned group leader. You will receive an ID tag and your child will be escorted to the Blue Door area.
 - We will offer a quick tour covering backstage, check-in, and check-out procedures.
 - Only parents that have signed up as backstage volunteers will be allowed backstage except during the tour.
- Pick-up
 - Creative Dance and level 6-8 dancers will be picked up at the Blue Door at the base of the lobby stairs.
 - Wednesday, the 4:15 arrival group will be dismissed before the 5:30 group begins.
 - Friday, the Buddy & Me dancers will be dismissed before the next group begins.
 - Friday, Kinder Ballet and Ballet 6-8 Beginning/Intermediate will have extra time to practice before the full show run through. Please plan to stay until they are dismissed.
 - Bring your child's ID tag to pick-up your child.



PERFORMANCE - CREATIVE & 6-8 CLASSES

- Arrival
 - Please arrive 30 minutes before your show curtain time.
 - Arrive in costume with hair and make-up done.
 - Dancers may wear street shoes and bring dance shoes with them.
 - If your dancer is in multiple classes in one show, send the extra costume(s) with them at check-in.
 - Label everything clearly and only bring essentials. We will provide simple activities for down time.
 - Only dry snacks and clear, non-flavored water will be allowed backstage.
- Backstage access
 - Only parents that have signed up as backstage volunteers will be allowed backstage.
 - Enter and exit through the marked doorway. There will be signs to guide you to the Dancer Entrance. Please do not enter through the lobby except for pick-up after the show.
 - There will be a check-in table at the Dancer Entrance. Here we will give you an ID tag for post-performance pick-up, and we will connect your child with his or her group leader.
- Pick-up
 - After the Finale number, proceed to the base of the lobby staircase to the Blue Door pick-up area used during rehearsal. Due to the need for quick transitions and limited space, please send one adult (not siblings) with the provided ID tag to pick up your dancer(s).
 - Friends and family should wait outside in the courtyard to visit and congratulate your dancer on a wonderful performance.
 - Costumes are not allowed in the lobby or auditorium, so plan to bring a change of clothes if your dancer(s) will be staying to watch the other performances.



REHEARSAL - LEVEL I+

Arrival

- Please be in the auditorium by your arrival time, with hair and makeup done.
 - You may arrive a few minutes early to place your personal belongings in the costume rooms downstairs. Costumes should be brought on their hangers with all accessories organized. Please label everything!
 - Dancers may put on costumes after they are released from the auditorium to the backstage area.
 - We recommend wearing leggings over tights to protect those new tights! Dancers in multiple classes can give their extra costume(s) to their class helper when they check in.
- Backstage Access & Tour
 - After announcements, we will offer a quick tour covering backstage, check-in, and check-out procedures.
 - Only parents that have signed up as backstage volunteers will be allowed backstage except during the tour.
 - Please discuss appropriate backstage behavior with your child before arrival.
 - Level 1 Dancers will have a volunteer supervisor to answer questions, address needs, and encourage appropriate backstage behavior.
 - Dancers in levels 2 and above will not have direct supervision and will be responsible for themselves and their possessions. The studio will provide staff only to assist older dancers with quick changes, and getting lined up and onto the stage.
- Dismissal
 - Dancers are free to leave after their last number is released from the stage unless the instructor asks them to stay for notes or additional rehearsal.



PERFORMANCE - LEVEL 1+

- Arrival
 - Dancers should enter and exit through the marked doors; look for signs to guide you. Non-dancers will not be admitted backstage.
 - Bring everything you need for performance with you. Do not bring anything extra.
 - Dancers are expected to keep their belongings contained. We suggest a small box or laundry basket for dancers in multiple shows.
 - Please bring only essentials and label all items with the dancer's name.
 - Only dry snacks and clear, non-flavored water will be allowed backstage.
- Backstage access
 - Only parents that have signed up to volunteer backstage will be allowed backstage.
- Dismissal
 - After the Finale (dancers will not be released early), dancers will exit the backstage area.
 We ask that dancers exit as quickly as possible with all belongings unless they are dancing in the next scheduled performance.
 - Level 1 dancers can be picked up by the backstage entrance door in the downstairs lobby. Please send only one adult for pick-up as the lobby area will be crowded.
 - Dancers in level 2 and above will be released to the courtyard.
 - Friends and family should wait outside in the courtyard to visit and congratulate their dancer on a wonderful performance
 - Costumes are not allowed in the lobby or auditorium. Dancers who plan to stay and watch the other performances should plan to bring a change of clothes.

PLEASE NOTE: Our highest priority backstage is to ensure safety for all the dancers. One way we can accomplish this is to keep backstage traffic to a minimum. We do not allow non-volunteers access to the backstage areas. If you know you will want to be with your dancer backstage, be sure to sign up for a position early as spots can fill quickly.

TICKET SALES

New in 2024, tickets are available for online purchasing starting Friday, April 5, 2024. Because you are able to purchase online tickets at your convenience, we will not have in person ticket sales available prior to show dates. If you have questions or need assistance with the online process, please stop by the office during normal business hours and we will gladly assist. We encourage you to purchase early for the best value and seat selection.

- Single Show Adult: \$15
- Single Show Children Age 2-12: \$10
- Multiple Show Adult (same day only): \$20
- Multiple Show Children (same day only) Ages 2-12: \$15

*At the door prices will increase to \$20 for Adult/\$25 for a Multiple Show Adult (same day). Children's prices will remain the same.

**Children under age 2 may sit in a parent's lap. The space between rows is narrow. If your child is quite wiggly or prone to kicking, please consider purchasing a seat for them so that nearby audience members are also able to have a good experience.

POST RECITAL INFO

Post-recital weeks are an important part of our dance year and all students are expected to participate. Below you'll find a brief overview of what to anticipate for the weeks following recital. Additional details will be provided as we move closer to these dates.

May 13-18: CLASS PHOTO & COMMUNITY PERFORMANCE PREP

All classes will be held at their regular times. Please come in costume with hair/makeup done. Multi-day classes will be held both days, but only have photo time during one class. Parents will have an opportunity to take individual and group photos and classes will also spend time rehearsing for community performances.

May 20-25: COMMUNITY PERFORMANCES

Once again, we are looking forward to blessing residents of our community with the dances students and teachers have prepared throughout the year. The community has warmly received these performances, and we always hear many positive comments from the venues where we perform. Please help your dancer(s) understand what an opportunity we have to be a blessing to people who would not otherwise have access to such an uplifting performance.

Your child will perform on the same day(s) he or she takes class, with the exception of Saturday classes, due to Memorial weekend. You can anticipate an arrival time of 3:45pm, with performances beginning at 4:00pm. Showcases run around 60-90 min. Ballet IV, Choreography, and Drama III will be spread out through the week. My Buddy & Me and Saturday Creative Dance will perform on Friday.
